

Supply list for oil and acrylic class for June Heimsoth.

Oil painters:

- Phthalo blue, green shade (pb 15) Windsor blue Windsor and Newton
- Permanent rose or quinacridone rose (pv 19) Windsor and Newton
- Hansa yellow medium (py 74) Windsor and Newton called Windsor yellow
- Titanium white (pw 6) I like Gamlin. Any brand is acceptable these are my favorites determined from years of working with this very limited palette.
- Odorless thinner Don't buy paint store thinner. Only quality thinner from art supply stores. Gamlin or Turpinoid is preferred.
- Roll of paper towels.
- Richensen grey matters tinted disposable palette paper 12x16 is better than the small size.. Or any palette you prefer.
- Small assortment of brushes in sizes you are comfortable with.
- Something to paint on. Canvas, gessoed Masonite, canvas pad in smaller sizes (9x12, 8x10, 11x14. If you insist on painting something large that's ok too.

Acrylic painters

- Liquitex or Golden paints are the best in my opinion.
- Phthalocyanine blue green shade pb 15
- Magenta or rose pv 19 in some brands it is only available as pr 122
- Golden Hansa yellow medium OPAQUE. They make one that it more transparent. don't buy that one. The number is py 74. It may have another name but the number is py 74.
- Small spray bottle to mist your paint and a plastic cup or tub to rinse your brushes.
- Small assortment of brushes Flat or filbert. A small detail brush if you like.
- Canvas any suitable painting surface (not too large)

Please don't buy "sets" of assorted paint. They usually are poor quality and most of the colors are useless for my method.

If you have been painting for years and are married to your own paint colors and really don't want to buy any paint-so be it.
